CHNOPS Activity Biology

In Biology, there are six common elements that are involved in most biological reactions. The elements are:

Carbon Hydrogen Nitrogen Oxygen Phosphorus Sulfure

A common mnemonic device to remember the six elements is to call them "CHNOPS".
