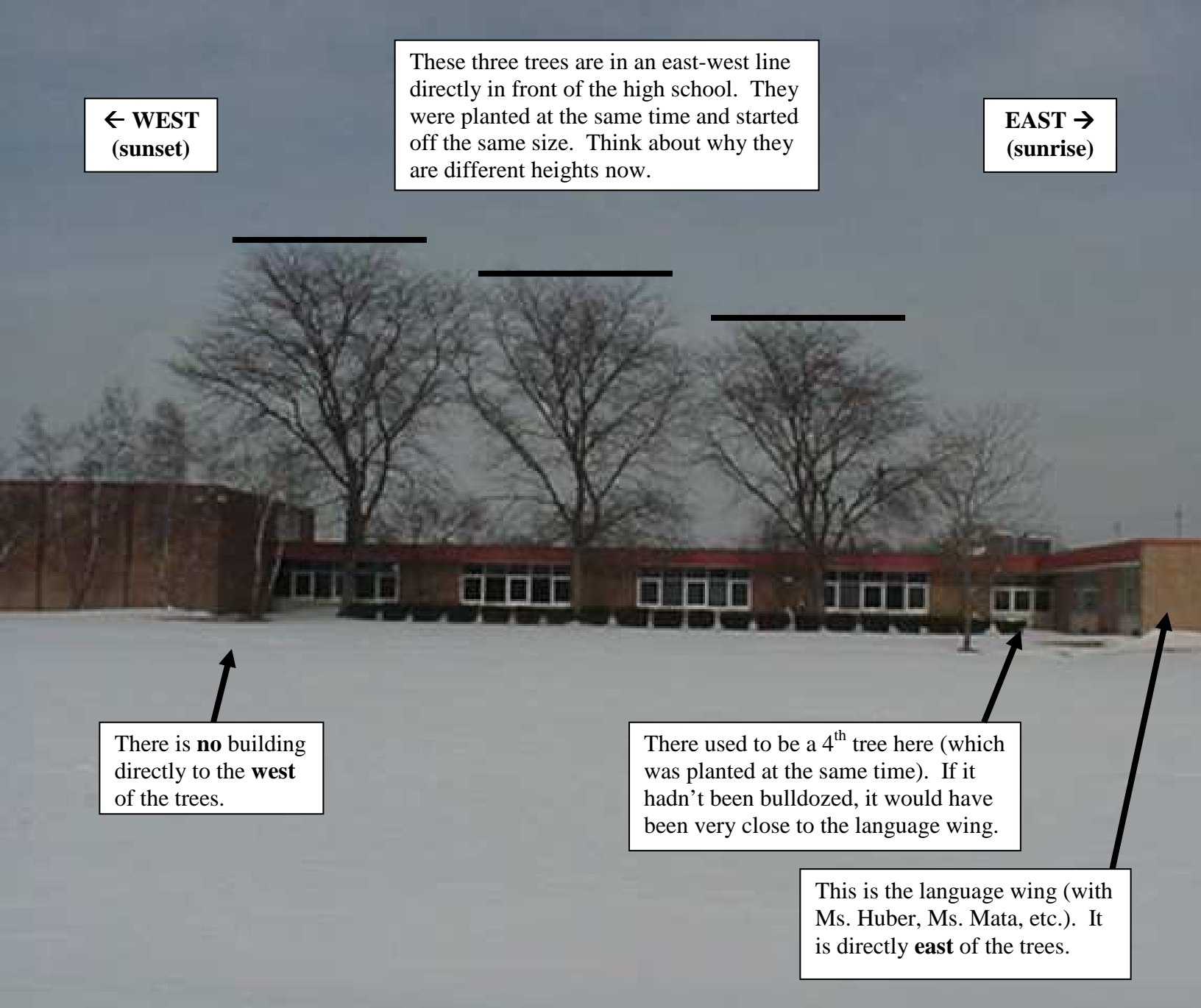


**THREE TREES ESSAY ASSIGNMENT**

This is the view you would have if you were standing in front of Lincoln High School, with your back to Willis Road. Carefully observe the picture below and read the “Tree Essay” half-sheet handout to complete the assignment.



These three trees are in an east-west line directly in front of the high school. They were planted at the same time and started off the same size. Think about why they are different heights now.

← WEST  
(sunset)

EAST →  
(sunrise)

There is **no** building directly to the **west** of the trees.

There used to be a 4<sup>th</sup> tree here (which was planted at the same time). If it hadn't been bulldozed, it would have been very close to the language wing.

This is the language wing (with Ms. Huber, Ms. Mata, etc.). It is directly **east** of the trees.
